Harris v Moses, in the matter of Harris [2025] FCA 886 – successfully opposed application to set aside a bankruptcy notice or extend time for compliance pursuant to s 41(6A) of the Bankruptcy Act 1966 (Cth) - applicant failed to apply for stay of judgment or adduce any evidence as to financial circumstances – application dismissed.
